**Robert J. Newman Named President,  
Corcoran Jennison Hospitality, LLC**

*Overseeing the Cape's Ocean Edge Resort and Golf Club and 3 other CJH properties*

**Boston, MA:** Robert J. Newman has been named President of Corcoran Jennison Hospitality, LLC, overseeing management and operations of Ocean Edge Resort and Golf Club in Brewster, Cape Cod, MA; Doubletree Downtown Hotel, Boston; Doubletree Bayside Hotel, Boston; and the Hampton Inn at Crosstown Center, Boston.

For the past three years Mr. Newman has been the General Manager of Ocean Edge Resort and Golf Club. Ocean Edge is a 429-acre resort, featuring 334 guest villas and hotel rooms, 15,000 square feet of meeting space, and a turn-of-the-century Mansion and Carriage house overlooking Cape Cod Bay.

Under Mr. Newman's direction, Ocean Edge completed a \$19.5 million renovation, including the privatization and redesign of an \$8 million Nicklaus Design golf course, expansion of the Linx Clubhouse, build-out of a member-only lounge, expanded locker rooms, a 2,500 square foot Linx Pavilion to host events, tournaments and meetings, and the a 4,500 square feet Mansion Ballroom and Ocean Terrace restaurant that overlooks Cape Cod Bay.

"Bob's tenacity to see these projects through completion and have them generate substantial income even during financial difficult times for the hospitality industry has been remarkable," said Joseph E. Corcoran, Chairman of the Corcoran Jennison Companies. "Our other hotel properties will benefit from Bob's attention, and we are looking forward to his leadership."

Mr. Newman was the recipient of the 2008 Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce Business Excellence Award for his many contributions to the Cape Cod community where Mr. Newman serves on the Board of Directors for Latham Centers Inc., a center for developmentally and emotionally challenged individuals.

Prior to taking the helm at Ocean Edge, Mr. Newman was General Manager of two Corcoran Jennison Hospitality owned properties; in 1999 the 197-room Doubletree Boston Bayside, and in 2001 the 268-room Doubletree Hotel Downtown Boston.

Under Mr. Newman's management the Doubletree Boston Bayside was a recipient of Hilton Hotels "Go for the Green" Award in 2005; one of only 32 Hilton properties and only 9 Doubletree properties to receive the award.

A native of Kildare, Ireland, Mr. Newman is a graduate of Trinity College in Dublin, and has a B.S. Degree with Honors in Business Management. He is also a graduate of Dublin College of Hotel and Catering Management and holds a Higher Diploma (Honors) in Hotel Catering and Management.
